



Low Speed Electric Vehicles

AKA golf carts

The Town of White lake and its Police

Department acknowledge and follow North Carolina's general statutes regarding low speed vehicles:

- All operators must hold a valid license to drive a motor vehicle.
- All occupants must use seatbelts.
- Low speed vehicles may be operated on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 35mph or less.
- Low speed vehicles must be registered and insured in accordance to G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-309
- Must be inspected by NC Service Station or by an out of state service station that has identical standards as NC.
- **Must have the following equipment to comply with state law:**
Headlamps, Parking Brakes, RearviewMirrors, Reflex Reflectors, Seat Belts, Speedometer, Stop Lamps, Tail Lamps, Turn Signal Lamps, VIN, Windshield, and Windshield Wipers.

NC G.S. 20-4.07(27)

defines a low speed vehicle as: a 4wheeled ELECTRIC vehicle whose speed is greater than 20 mph but less than 25 mph.

All of the following laws and standards apply to low speed vehicles.
